MAIN ACHIEVEMENTS OF P&M ORGANIZATION DURING 2^{HD} QUARTER ENDING SEPTEMBER, 2016.

- Transmission availability for the quarter ending September, 2016 is 99.93% might be all time record during Paddy Season with available skeletal manpower. During this tenure one post of Dy.CE/P&M, Jalandhar, Two posts of Addl.SE and more than 70 posts of SSE remained lying vacant. Position would have been certainly more better had the above mentioned posts of Engineers would have been file, along with 114 ALMs. And about 20 SSAs working in TS Organization have been allowed to join P&M Organization as their pay is being charged to P&M Organization and the duty of SSA is only to man substation.
- Uninterrupted power supply provided during paddy season Inspite of the fit that ICT-1 of 500MVA capacity at Bhalwan remained under shutdown due to technical snag. ICT-2 of 500MVA capacity at Bhalwan remained partially loaded due to formation of abnormal dangerous gases and ICT-3 of 500MVA capacity is still to commission due to wrong laying of foundation of cooling bank.
- Transmission system remained smooth inspite of the fact 3-4 times breakdown occurred in 220KV double circuit Khassa-Balachak line.
- 220KV substation, Majra commissioned during the first fortnight of july, 2016.
- 400KV substation Rajpura- ICT of 500MVA charged on 18/07/2016.
- 220KV substation, Badal commissioned on 11/08/2016.
- 220KV substation, Jadla commissioned on 12/08/2016.
