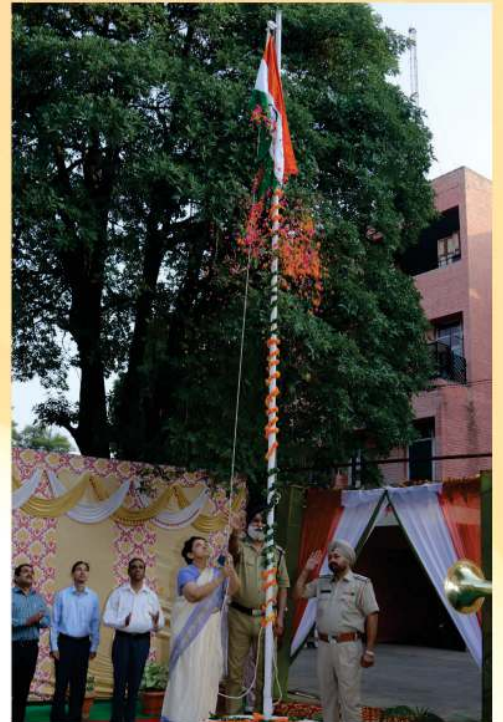




# Independence Day-2017 Celebrations
