It is pertinent to mention here that Hon'ble Chief Secv./ Govt. of Pb. vide aforesaid letter directed to prepare a list of the court orders which are yet to be complied with. If in some case, the Department feels that the order needs to be challenged, LPA/SLP (as the case may be) should be filed immediately and prayer for staying the operation of the impugned order be made. In all other cases, the orders of Hon'ble High Court should be complied with immediately in order to avoid harsh orders in Contempt Petitions.

Accordingly, you are hereby requested to direct / instruct all concerned officers / officials under your control to make strict compliance of orders of Hon'ble High Court in letter and spirit, especially where the directions are to "pass speaking order" or decide the claim within stipulated time to avoid imposition of cost. If in some case, the concerned office of PSTCL feels that the order needs to be challenged, LPA/SLP (as the case may be) should be filed immediately and prayer for staying the operation of the impugned order be made.

In case any COCP is filed or adverse order is passed due to noncompliance of High Court orders within stipulated time, then concerned controlling officer(s)/ official(s) will be accountable for the same & would be responsible for depositing the cost(s) as imposed by Hon'ble Court from their personal pocket.

- 2. It has been observed that in some cases, State is made a party through Chief Secretary. As you are aware, in most such cases, the compliance of the Orders of Hon'ble Court is to be made by the Competent Authority within the Department as per its Standing Order.
- 3. If in some case, the Department feels that the Order needs to be challenged, LPA/SLP (as the case may be) should be filed immediately and prayer for staying the operation of the impugned order be made. In all other cases, the Orders of the Hon'ble Court should be complied with immediately in order to avoid harsh orders in Contempt Petitions.
- 4. If in case of lapse on part of any Department, a Contempt Petition is filed against the undersigned, a very serious view of the same will be taken and deterrent action will be taken against the Officer concerned. This should be brought to the notice of all concerned.

Sub: Compliance of the orders of Hon'ble High Court.

- Today, Hon'ble Mr. Justice Harkesh Manuja (who is hearing the Contempt Petitions) directed the undersigned to appear before him through VC.
- Hon'ble High Court flagged the issue of non compliance of its orders. It was pointed out that in some cases orders were passed by the Hon'ble Courts to the Competent Authority to pass Speaking Orders. Even such orders remain uncomplied with, forcing the petitioners to file Contempt Petitions.

3. Hon'ble Court made it clear that after week from now, if it comes across any instance of non compliance of its orders by any Officer, it will impose deterrent costs and the same will have to be borne by the erring Officers from their own pockets.

- In light of above, you are directed to prepare a list of all the Court Orders which are yet to be complied with. If in some case, the Department feels that the order needs to be challenged, LPA/SLP (as the case may be) should be filed immediately and prayer for staying the operation of the impugned order be made. In all other cases, the orders of the Hon'ble Court should be complied with immediately in order to avoid harsh orders in Contempt Petitions.
- Administrative Secretaries, Head of Departments, Managing Directors of the Corporations and Deputy Commissioners are to monitor all this personally.
- 6. This should be treated as Most Important.
